- Local Area Network Device Information: The Application communicates with devices such as cameras, equatorial mounts, and guide cameras within the local area network. Information used includes the device's IP address and port number. This information is only used to establish device connections and control operations, with all data processing done locally. The Application does not store, upload, or communicate this information to external servers.
- Camera Control and Photo Storage: The Application controls the camera via the LAN for imaging operations. Photos taken are stored directly on the device connected to the camera, such as a computer or storage device. We do not upload these photos to the cloud or any other server, nor do we perform remote backups.

Logs and Diagnostic Information: During the operation of the Application, we do
not actively record or collect any user activity logs, error reports, or diagnostic
information. The Application is designed for fully localized operation, ensuring
no interference with user privacy.

2. How We Share, Transfer, or Disclose Your Personal Information

As the Application does not collect, store, or process any user data, there is no sharing or disclosure of information. We do not share any user data with third parties, nor do we sell or rent personal information in any form.

3. How We Protect Your Personal Information

Although the Application does not involve the storage or processing of personal data, we are committed to ensuring the security of your device's operating environment. To help protect your LAN, we recommend the following measures:

- Regular Firmware Updates: Ensure that the firmware and control software for devices like cameras, equatorial mounts, and guide cameras are kept up to date to minimize potential security risks.
